**Whereas**, there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Litchfield, Minnesota, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of *Jorjus Haraldson*

has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the west half of the southeast quarter, and the south-east quarter of the south-east quarter of section two, in township one hundred and twenty-three, of range forty-two, in the district of lands formerly subject to sale at Litchfield, now Benson, Minnesota, containing one hundred and twenty acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES, unto the said *Jorjus Haraldson*, the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Jorjus Haraldson* and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, *J. Rutherford B. Hayes*, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
