GEORGE CARLTON HEGLAND

George Carlton Hegland was born November 9, 1900 at Fosston, Minnesota to parents Thor and Lena Hegland. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith and was a member of Salem Lutheran Church. He was united in marriage to Ellen Johnson on August 2, 1930 at Herman, Minnesota.

Mr. Hegland worked in banks at Hettinger, Rogers and Edgeley, North Dakota, after completing school at Dakota Business College. In 1927 he became assistant National Bank receiver and worked in several banks in South Eastern, North Dakota, living in Oakes and Edgeley, North Dakota. In 1935 he was employed by the Reconstruction Finance Corporation as field representative working in liquidation work in National Banks in the North Western part of North Dakota. He moved to the Minneapolis office of the RFC as an examiner in 1945. He worked in this capacity until 1963 when he moved to McIntosh and worked in the First National Bank until his retirement in 1967. He was city treasurer of McIntosh for a number of years and served on the church council of Salem Lutheran Church as long as his health permitted.

George C. Hegland passed away Saturday, April 19, 1975 at the Fosston Hospital

74 years, 5 months, 10 days.
